COURSE FORMAT

The TEFL course is 140 hours in total, completed over 4 weeks. You will be training Monday to Friday, from 10:00 am to 16:00 pm. Teaching practicals will take place in the evenings outside these times. You'll also be required to do some research, homework and lesson planning during your downtime. There's a lot to cover, but it'll prepare you to be a fantastic TEFL teacher.



TEACHING PRACTICES

There are 10 hours of observed general teaching practices, plus you'll have the opportunity to teach 5 hours of language lessons and another 5 hours of practicals. In total, 20 hours of teaching with students.



TYPE OF ASSESSMENT

You will be constantly observed and assessed throughout the course. There is an exam and coursework. This is all externally moderated and approved by the accreditation board.



COURSE LOCATION AND CENTRE

The TEFL center is around 5 blocks from the beach right in the heart of Puerto Vallarta. It's a modern, bright building, with the language school attached. Meaning you don't have to travel for your teaching practicals.



REQUIREMENTS

To do the TEFL course need to be at least 21 years old (although each case is considered on a case by case basis). You can also be a non-native speaker of English as long as you have a level C1 or above, which will be tested during the interview. You do not need a Bachelors degree, nor need to know any Spanish – although it's useful for day to day living.



JOB MARKET AND EMPLOYMENT POSSIBILITY

There are a number of TEFL jobs throughout the country. You'll have full assistance in securing your TEFL role after training. The team will ensure your needs are met. There are opportunities in schools, language centers, and depending on experience, universities.



VISA REQUIREMENTS

Visa information changes all the time. Most candidates enter on a 180-day visa on arrival, meaning there's no paperwork to prepare in advance. Following the course and once you've secured your new job, you'll be guided through the process of applying for a work permit. WORK IN MEXICO

In Mexico, there are English teaching jobs throughout the country. The most popular locations are Mexico City, Leon, San Luis Potosi, Guadalajara, Puerto Vallarta and Tuxtla Gutiérrez to name just a few.

There are teaching positions in two different settings. Public schools make up around 50% of roles, and the other 50% is in language centres. Schools adhere to traditional terms-time schedules, and language centres operate all year round, so you'll secure a new teaching job with ease at any point in the year.

Public schools teach a range of ages, from kindergarten to high school. In language centers you can expect to teach a wide range of students, from children all the way to business professionals and adults. Our team work with you during the course, to secure the role you'd prefer in your chosen location in Mexico.
