COURSE FORMAT

This course is a Trinity CertTESOL, either completed over 4 weeks. It's a full time, intensive schedule. You'll be training for 160 hours in 4 weeks, with homework and assignments to complete also.



TEACHING PRACTICES

There are 6+ hours of observed teaching practicals throughout the course, these are also varied so you can practise your teaching with different groups and ability levels.



TYPE OF ASSESSMENT

There are 5 main modules to complete, each one must be passed to adhere to Trinity College's exacting standards.



COURSE LOCATION AND CENTRE

The training centre is in a prime location in Barcelona, surrounded by shops, gardens, museums and much more. You're a 15 minute walk from the beach, La Sagrada Familia and other famous attractions.



REQUIREMENTS

To complete the TEFL course you need to be at least 18 years old (although each applicant is considered on a case by case basis). You can also be a non-native speaker of English as long as you have a level C1 or above, which will be tested during the interview. A Bachelors degree (in any discipline) is preferred, however there are plenty of TEFL jobs for non degree holders.



JOB MARKET AND EMPLOYMENT POSSIBILITY

There's a good demand for TEFL teachers in Barcelona. You have exclusive access to teaching jobs with a partner language school, plus tools and support to work throughout the city.



VISA REQUIREMENTS

EU passport holders can live and work in Spain without restrictions. For non-EU passport holders, you will need a visa to live, study and work in Spain for longer than 3 months. TEFL Connect provides a course that allows non-EU passport holders a student visa for a year, which includes Professional Development classes, and you can legally work 20 hours per week. You not only receive your TEFL certification but constantly build on your skills at the same time!

WORK IN BARCELONA

There is a wide variety of TEFL teaching positions in Barcelona, working with all age ranges! You can teach adults, young learners, business English, and private tuition.

You also have the added benefit of a language school who hire exclusively from our course graduates! Meaning you have first access to teaching jobs there.

In Barcelona, TEFL teachers will typically work 20 hours per week, the rate of pay varies from €12 – €30 per hour, depending on class type and level of experience.

As a new teacher, you can expect to earn between €1000 – €1300 per month after tax, depending on how hard you work.
